Now! Why Aaaah! HalleluYaaah!

At various times, the Lord took me to different large mega churches, thinking to rest in His Presence, to worship! But He would give me revelations and cause me to feel and to share His anguish!

One large mega church one time was hosting a very famous well known prophet. When I was told of it, the Lord said I want you to go! So, I went! When the so called prophet or apostle (I'm not sure of title he's using!), was presented, he called the people to give a big applause to the Lord, and kept urging them on, that the atmosphere was so charged with the applause and the whistling and screaming, at one point I wondered who is receiving this!

And the prophet prophesied of good times coming ahead ... peace and prosperity... (I was very sad, as I was perceiving things in my spirit and receiving revelations from the Lord that caused me to anguish)!

I was afraid to accept what I was receiving from the Lord! There was so much pain, and fear that I was sinning against the Lord, and that what I was receiving was of myself and not from Him! As I ruled out the enemy according to the word of God:

"I John 4:1 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world. 2 Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God: 3 And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world."

I went home with such heaviness, arguing with the Lord all the time, even at home I was wrestling with the Lord, until at one point He touched me and gave great grace and peace, and said enough! Go to sleep!

The next day in my daily private time with the Lord in prayer and reading the Bible, the Lord was able to talk with me as I was calmer and well rested:

The Lord said: "When a minister and a certain ministry enjoy My presence, and with many miracles; salvations, deliverances, healings...; is no indication, that I'm well pleased with them and accept what they are doing at times, and in no way security that they shall inherit the kingdom of heaven!"

Stop thinking of how to answer me and to object yet! And don't raise your eyebrows yet! Well, you can! Raise your eyebrows that is.

The Lord continued: "Judas Iscariot enjoyed My presence all the time, even though I knew he was stealing from Me (John 12:6 - This he said, not that he cared for the poor; but because he was a thief, and had the bag, and bare what was put therein.), and I knew he is going to betray Me. Still I allowed him to continue in My presence, and he did many miracles in My name, and cast out demons in My name and healed people in My name. I even washed his feet, and fed him with My hand!

Did he inherit the kingdom of heaven?

And I said in My word in John 12:47 And if any man hear my words, and believe not (obey not), I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world. 48 He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day.

That's why I said in Matthew 7:21 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. 22 Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? 23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity."

The Lord took me again to that church, thinking this time to worship Him! I discovered that it was hosting an international conference for students, by an international organization that is doing a great work! That night was the closing night, and the place was filled with thousands of young people. After the ceremonies and praise, a very famous youth pastor was presented to preach.

He claimed that the Lord gave him the message he was to present that night, and that for every one to listen carefully. He caught my attention, as I thought this time I'll be on the receiving end, and get blessed!

He started with what I perceived to be a very subtle injection of anesthetic. And called the young people to come and eat of the bread (his message!!?) the Father has for them, and not to worry now about their sins i.e. pornography, adultery, fornication, etc...The Father loves them, and anyway He said in His word in the Lord's Prayer; Give us this day our daily bread first, and then after that forgive us our sins.

And then in the message he went to encourage the kids not to wait for God to tell you what to do, you must go out and claim the land for God and as you take bold steps of

faith, you'd provoke God to follow you and act on your behalf and bless you! In many words he also used scriptures!

The more I listened to him, the more anguish I was feeling, but the more the kids were getting excited and screaming, especially the young girl behind me! When he called the kids to come forward and receive a special anointing from God, the Lord told me with firmness, GET OUT!

The next day, the anguish was so intense as the Lord was comparing what that preacher said and what the Lord's WORD says, and I was sobbing and crying with the Lord in anguish.

Especially I want to share the scriptures: John 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: Not that I will follow them!

Proverbs 14:12 There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death.

Acts 20:30 Also of your own selves shall men arise, speaking perverse things, to draw away disciples after them.

I think many churches claim to have received prophecies promising blessings and prosperity!

But here what this servant (I, trumpet) received from the Lord:

1Cor.14:29 Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the other judge.

1Thes.5:20 Despise not prophesyings. 21 Prove all things; hold fast that which is good.

Jeremiah 23

1 Woe be unto the pastors that destroy and scatter the sheep of my pasture! saith the LORD... 9 Mine heart within me is broken because of the prophets; all my bones shake; I am like a drunken man, and like a man whom wine hath overcome, because of the LORD, and because of the words of his holiness. 10 For the land is full of adulterers; for because of

swearing the land mourneth; the pleasant places of the wilderness are dried up, and their course is evil, and their force is not right. 11 For both prophet and priest are profane; yea, in my house have I found their wickedness, saith the LORD. 12 Wherefore their way shall be unto them as slippery ways in the darkness: they shall be driven on, and fall therein: for I will bring evil upon them, *even* the year of their visitation, saith the LORD. 13 And I have seen folly in the prophets of Samaria; they prophesied in Baal, and caused my people Israel to err. 14 I have seen also in the prophets of Jerusalem an horrible thing: they commit adultery, and walk in lies: they strengthen also the hands of evildoers, that none doth return from his wickedness: they are all of them unto me as Sodom, and the inhabitants thereof as Gomorrah. 15 Therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts concerning the prophets; Behold, I will feed them with wormwood, and make them drink the water of gall: for from the prophets of Jerusalem is profaneness gone forth into all the land. 16 Thus saith the LORD of hosts, Hearken not unto the words of the prophets that prophesy unto you: they make you vain: they speak a vision of their own heart, and not out of the mouth of the LORD. 17 They say still unto them that despise me, The LORD hath said, Ye shall have peace; and they say unto every one that walketh after the imagination of his own heart, No evil shall come upon you. 18 For who hath stood in the counsel of the LORD, and hath perceived and heard his word? who hath marked his word, and heard it? 19 Behold, a whirlwind of the LORD is gone forth in fury, even a grievous whirlwind: it shall fall grievously upon the head of the wicked. 20 The anger of the LORD shall not return, until he have executed, and till he have performed the thoughts of his heart: in the latter days ye shall consider it perfectly.

21 I have not sent these prophets, yet they ran: I have not spoken to them, yet they prophesied. 22 But if they had stood in my counsel, and had caused my people to hear my words, then they should have turned them from their evil way, and from the evil of their doings. 23 Am I a God at hand, saith the LORD, and not a God afar off? 24 Can any hide himself in secret places that I shall not see him? saith the LORD. Do not I fill heaven and earth? saith the LORD. 25 I have heard what the prophets said, that prophesy lies in my name, saying, I have dreamed, I have dreamed. 26 How long shall *this* be in the heart of the prophets that prophesy lies? yea, they are prophets of the deceit of their own heart;... 28 The prophet that hath a dream, let him tell a dream; and he that hath my word, let him speak my word faithfully. What is the chaff to the wheat? saith the LORD. 29 /s not my word like as a fire? saith the LORD; and like a hammer that breaketh the rock in pieces? 30 Therefore, behold, I am against the prophets, saith the LORD, that steal my words every one from his neighbour. 31 Behold, I am against the prophets, saith the LORD, that use their tongues, and say, He saith. 32 Behold, I am against them that prophesy false dreams, saith the LORD, and do tell them, and cause my people to err by their lies, and by their lightness; yet I sent them not, nor commanded them: therefore they shall not profit this people at all, saith the LORD.

Heb 12:25 See that ye refuse not him that speaketh. For if they escaped not who refused him that spake on earth, much more *shall not* we *escape*, if we turn away from him that *speaketh* from heaven: 26 Whose voice then shook the earth: but now he hath promised, saying, Yet once more I shake

not the earth only, but also heaven. 27 And this *word,* Yet once more, signifieth the removing of those things that are shaken, as of things that are made, that those things which cannot be shaken may remain. 28 Wherefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have grace, thereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear: 29 For our God *is* a consuming fire.

THE LORD SAID THAT HE WILL BEGIN TO JUDGE HIS HOUSE:

1Pe 4:15 But let none of you suffer as a murderer, or *as* a thief, or *as* an evildoer, or as a busybody in other men's matters. 6 Yet if *any man suffer* as a Christian, let him not be ashamed; but let him glorify God on this behalf. 7 For the time *is come* that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if *it* first *begin* at us, what shall the end *be* of them that obey not the gospel of God? 8 And if the righteous scarcely be saved, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear? 19 Wherefore let them that suffer according to the will of God commit the keeping of their souls *to him* in well doing, as unto a faithful Creator.

THE FIRE OF THE LORD IS COMING TO HIS HOUSE:

1Co 3:9 For we are labourers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building. 10 According to the grace of God which is given unto me, as a wise masterbuilder, I have laid the foundation, and another buildeth thereon. But let every man take heed how he buildeth thereupon.

11 For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ. 12 Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble; 13 Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire

shall try every man's work of what sort it is. 14 If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward. 15 If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire. 16 Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and *that* the Spirit of God dwelleth in you? 17 If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which *temple* ye are.

AND THE LORD IS SAYING TO HIS SAINTS (THE REPENTANT, THE CONVERTED, THE SANCTIFIED, THE OVERCOMERS):

Isa 60:1 Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee.

2 For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the LORD shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee.
