

Session II, March 5th.

The Overcomers.



Note: The following is taken from a seminar taught by Carlo Ma'ayeh in a Bible School in Ambon, Indonesia in 2013.

Prayer: *Lord Jesus, continue moving with power and glory in this place. Continue to teach us and equip us Lord. Prepare us for your soon coming our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. We continue to surrender to you Lord; to your Lordship and leadership. Continue teaching and equipping your saints in Jesus' name. We thank you Father, in Jesus' name. Amen.*

The Lord spoke to me to continue with the teaching, the equipping of the saints. We are happy to share testimonies as the Lord leads us (*the students shared beautiful testimonies of how the Word of God was working in their lives by the Holy Spirit*), but we don't have our own agenda, we keep hearing and obeying what He wants.

And the Lord told me: I want you to continue with the teaching I want you to give. So, let's open to the book of Revelations chapter 1 verses 5 and 6.

Revelations 1:5 And from Jesus Christ, *who is* the faithful witness, *and* the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood,

6 And has made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him *be* glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

Jesus washed us from our sins with his blood and made us kings and priest to God our Father. Then in chapters 2 and 3 the Lord sent messages to His Churches. And the seven churches represent the churches in those days and along the ages and the churches of our days today.

And the Lord confronts many of the churches and calls many of them to repentance.

Remember that to every church Jesus said I know your works. But with many of them, there are sins He had to confront. And to the churches He called to repent, he says: **Repent, and He who overcomes**, he promises a **reward**.

I want you with me, to focus on some of the rewards that Jesus promises to the overcomers from the churches.

In chapter 2 verse 26 to 29

Revelations 2:26 And he that overcomes, and keeps my works unto the end, **to him will I give power over the nations:**

27 And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father.

28 And I will give him the morning star.

29 He that has an ear, let him hear **what the Spirit says unto the churches.**

The Lord calls the church to repentance and the Lord promises: **He who overcomes** will receive power over the nations to rule with Jesus.

This promise, this reward is for all the Christians in the church? Is it for everybody? Or only the ones who overcome? Read the verse and answer according to what Jesus says. In verse 26

Who is this promise for? To everybody in the church? To all the Christians?

I don't want your learning or your faith to depend on me. I want you to depend on the Word of God. Because there are many false teachings in the world. There is much cheap grace, false grace from hell is being preached in different churches in the world. And many Christians, believers, are being deceived by this cheap grace.

So, we need to wake up and be the people after His own heart. To wake up and wake others up! We need to exhort one another and say: Hey, be careful with the cheap grace. These promises are not for everybody. It's not my words, it's not the translator's words. These are the words of Jesus, so please listen to the words of Jesus. And then speak to others the words of Jesus. So, everybody's faith will be based on the words of God. On the Word of God, not on us, or our interpretation.

There is no interpretation here, these are simple words. Jesus said to the church: Repent! And the one who overcomes, Jesus promises them to receive power over the nations to rule.

Many believe this is for everybody. No! It's time to pay attention, to listen to what Jesus says. This is not for everybody. But it is for everybody who repents and overcomes.

..."he who has ears to hear let him hear what the Spirit says to **THE CHURCHES**". So, the Holy Spirit is speaking to the churches.

In chapter 3 verses 5 and 6

Revelations 3:5 **He that overcomes, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.**

6 He that has an ear, let him hear **what the Spirit says unto the churches.**

So, here is another church Jesus calls to repentance. He says: Repent! He that overcomes shall be clothed with white raiment.

This promise is for everybody? Or only for the ones who repent and are overcomers? Only the overcomers, those who repent and overcome, they receive white raiments.

But pay attention what Jesus says. Also the one who repents and overcomes **I will not blot out his name from the book of life**. What does it mean? If Jesus says the one who repents and overcomes I will not blot out his name from the book of life, what happens to the one who do not repent and do not overcome?

Those **who don't** repent and **don't overcome** are in danger of having their names blotted out from the book of life. True?

Because there is a false teaching pastor (the translator), around the world: **once saved, forever saved. No matter what you do.** (*students laughed*) Maybe you laugh now, but we were persecuted for teaching this. We were not persecuted by the world, we were persecuted by people in the church. Even in Australia, even in America. So, don't think in all the world the churches are good and beautiful.

Thank God there are churches that are overcomers, but there are other churches that are deceived. So, we need to go and wake them up! We need to believe the words of Jesus, and speak the words of Jesus. And tell other brothers and sisters in the world: Wake up! Don't be deceived! Don't believe the lies! Don't believe the cheap grace.

The grace of God does not allow us to live in sin. **The grace of God is able to save us from sin. The grace of God will enable us to be overcomers!**

That's why we run to the throne of grace, to receive mercy when we fall and find the grace to help us when we need it. And the grace of God is always available to help us, the power of God to save us, the power of God to overcome.

Hebrews 4:16 Let us therefore **come boldly unto the throne of grace**, that we may **obtain mercy**, and **find grace** to help in time of need.

When the Lord told me: Come... And he started teaching me and open the book of Revelations to me, I was afraid, and I said: *Lord, who can overcome?* Like when Peter asked Jesus: Who can be saved? And Jesus answered him what is impossible to men, is possible to God!

So, to my question the Lord answered me in Arabic:.... (*Carlo says the words in Arabic with a rhyme*) and it rhymes in Arabic, but in English it means: "The overcomers are the repentant ones"

***"The ones who overcome are the ones who truly repent. I know and see the heart of every person. He who is broken before me and repentant and cries for my grace, I will empower them! I will give them the grace to overcome"* Says the Lord.**

So, be encouraged! The grace of God is sufficient for you. As you choose to obey, as you choose to walk with Jesus, as you keep asking for grace, Jesus will empower you! He will strengthen you! He overcame, He will make you overcome as you trust him and obey him! Amen?

Here we see from the Word of God, that not all Christians, (so called Christians), not everybody in the church will receive power with Jesus to rule over nations. Not everyone will receive white raiment, because Jesus promised these rewards only to the ones who repent and overcome. Amen!

Let's look at another reward in chapter 3 verses 21 and 22.

Revelations 3:21 To him that overcomes will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.

22 He that has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says unto the churches.

Here, Jesus called another church to repentance. And Jesus promises to the ones who repent and overcome, to sit on thrones with him. So, who can sit on thrones with Jesus, everybody?

No! Only the ones who repent and overcome.

If you noticed after each promise there is an exhortation: **he who has ears to hear LET HIM HEAR what the Spirit is saying to the CHURCHES!**

Notice these admonitions are: for ALL THE CHURCHES. Not for one church. Amen?

Now, let's go to heaven!... In chapter 4, look at the scene after the letters to the churches. What is happening in heaven?


Rev 4:1 After this...

And in heaven John sees... verse 4, chapter 4...

Revelations 4:4 And round about the throne *were* four and twenty seats: and upon the seats I saw four and twenty elders sitting, clothed in white raiment; and they had on their heads crowns of gold.

Verse 4, we see in heaven the throne of God surrounded with twenty four thrones. On the twenty four thrones are elders. The elders are **sitting on thrones, clothed with white raiment and with crowns of gold to rule, to reign.**

Who are these?



Let's listen to them, who they say they are. In chapter 5 verses 8 to 10, please.

Revelations 5:8 And when he had taken the book, the four beasts and four *and* twenty elders fell down before the Lamb, having every one of them harps, and golden vials full of odors, which are the prayers of saints.

5:9 And they sung a new song, saying, You are worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for you were slain, **and have redeemed us to God by your blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;**

5:10 **And have made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.**

So, the twenty four elders confessed that they are **redeemed by the blood of Jesus; from the earth; from every people every tribe and every tongue. They are from every nation, every people, every tribe and every tongue. Sitting on thrones, clothed with white raiments with crowns of gold to reign over the nations.**

Whom did Jesus promise to sit on thrones?

- Those who repent and overcome.

From every nation, every people, every tribe and every tongue.

Whom did Jesus promise to give white raiments?

- Those who repent and overcome.

From every nation, every people, every tribe and every tongue.

Whom did Jesus promise to rule over the nations, to receive crowns of gold to reign over the nations?

- The ones who repent and overcome.

From every nation, every people, every tribe and every tongue. So, not only the apostles of Jesus are in this group. True?

But why number twenty four? How can they be twenty four and they are from every nation? Are there twenty four nations on the earth? Or, more? Can it be only twenty four tribes on the earth? No!...

So, that means that number twenty four is **symbolic number**, a **representative number**. Like when Jesus says: "Speak to the angel of the church of Philadelphia". Is He speaking only to one angel or is he speaking to everybody in the church represented by the one angel?

That means one angel represents many in the church from every nation, every people, every tribe and every tongue.

So, why number twenty four? To understand, always the scripture answers scripture and explains scriptures. Amen?

Let's go to the book of Acts chapter 15 verses 15 to 17,

Acts 15:15 And to this agree the words of the prophets; as it is written,

16 After this I will return, and **will build again the tabernacle of David**, which is fallen down; and I will build again the ruins thereof, and I will set it up:

17 That the residue of men might seek after the Lord, and all the Gentiles, upon whom my name is called, says the Lord, who does all these things.

We see here the blue print of the church, the design of the church, the arrangement of the church. God says in the later days I will restore the fallen tent of David. He did not say: I will restore the tabernacle of Moses. He did not say: I will restore the temple of Salomon. But He will restore the fallen tent of David. So, the design of the church that pleases God is conforming to the tent of David.



So let's see how the priests were arranged in the tent of David. Remember the twenty four elders? They say: "you redeemed us and made us kings and **priests**". So, let's see how the priests were arranged in the tabernacle of David. In 1st Chronicles 24 talks about the divisions of the priests in the tent of David.

1Chronicles 24:1 Now *these are* the divisions of the sons of Aaron. The sons of Aaron; Nadab, and Abihu, Eleazar, and Ithamar.

In verse 2 Nadab and Abihu died, and had no children,

1Chronicles 24:2 But Nadab and Abihu died before their father, and had no children: therefore Eleazar and Ithamar executed the priest's office.

We see that Eleazar and Ithamar had many children and grandchildren, so the order of the priesthood was for the children of Aaron. This is a symbolic priesthood for the priesthood of Melchizedek.

In the tabernacle of David there were many priests descendents of Eleazar and Ithamar. Because there were so many, they divided them in divisions and each division was represented by the head of that family. So we see in verse 5,

1Chronicles 24:5 Thus were they divided by lot, one sort with another; for the governors of the sanctuary, and governors *of the house* of God, were of the sons of Eleazar, and of the sons of Ithamar.

And verse 7 the first lot came to...

1Chronicles 24:7 Now the first lot came forth to Jehoiarib, the second to Jedaiah,...

So it continues second, third, fourth, fifth and so on, until verse 18,

1Chronicles 24:18 The three and twentieth to Delaiah, the four and twentieth to Maaziah.

We see **twenty four divisions of priests** represented by the chief of each house. But even though they are twenty four who are mentioned, each one of them has many in their division. Like seven angels mentioned in Revelations but many represented by the one angel of each church, which represents all the churches. As we keep hearing: he that has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit is saying **to the churches**.

Pay attention to verse 19,

1 Chronicles 24:19 These *were* the orderings of them in their service to come into the house of the LORD, according to their manner, under Aaron their father, **as the LORD God of Israel had commanded him**.

So, these are the orderings of them in their service to execute the office of the priest. Note, it is written as the Lord God of Israel **had commanded**, so it is not coincidence it is divine appointment. God foresaw the future and he saw twenty four divisions of priests, therefore he commanded David to divide them in twenty four divisions. The end of verse 19: ...as the LORD God of Israel had commanded him.

This is not a coincidence that this division was commanded by God in the tabernacle of David and God says in the later days I will restore the fallen tent of David.

So, we see in heaven twenty four divisions of elders around the throne from every nation, every people, every tribe and every tongue, redeemed from the earth by the blood of Jesus, with crowns of gold to rule, with white raiments, seated on thrones. These are the **overcomers**, and they are already in heaven. Their number complete, their rewards received; their work is finished and they are seated.

Now, when is this going to happen? Can we know? Thank God we can.

Session III, 5th March.

The overcomers in heaven.



HalleluYah! Are you all being edified today? Did you understand all I shared with you so far?

It's important that we all understand. It's our responsibility to wake up to righteousness and wake others up.

What I told you today is the Word of God and all based on what Jesus said. It is all based on the Word of God, so your faith will depend on what is written here. Your responsibility is to believe it and speak it, according to the Word. No more or less. Amen?

Because sometimes people will oppose you, even some churches. Don't be surprised, don't be discouraged. Keep your eyes on Jesus and follow Jesus, and speak the truth in love. Be pleasing to God not to men, like Paul says to the Galatians in chapter 1,

Galatians 1:10b ... or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ.

Always seek to please God not men. Because it happened that I was invited to preach in one church, and they heard me preaching this teaching somewhere else, so before I could preach in their church an elder of the church called me and said: Please, don't preach of this part of the Bible. Don't teach about this. Teach of the other side of the Bible, about the goodness of God. Don't teach this. I said: I'm sorry, I'll preach and teach what God tells me to preach and teach. The elder said: Why are you stubborn? I said: Thank you, God bless you. I'll preach what God tells me to preach.

So, the next day the pastor himself called me and said: I'm sorry we have to cancel your preaching.

[Rom 11:22 Behold therefore the goodness and severity of God: on them which fell, severity; but toward thee, goodness, if thou continue in *his* goodness: otherwise thou also shalt be cut off. (verse added while editing this document by the prompting of the Lord).

2Th 2:10 And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; **because they received not the love of the truth**, that they might be saved. (verse added while editing this document by the prompting of the Lord).]

Why does the Lord tell me to share this with you? For you to pray, pray for the churches, pray for people to receive the love for the truth. Pray that God make you a lover of the truth. Even if the truth hurts, you will love it and receive it. The truth will set you free and you will be pleasing to God. And your reward is from Jesus not from people. Amen?

Let's continue with the book of Revelations. We said that we can see the number of the overcomers complete in heaven, already seated on thrones, with white raiments and crowns; already taken to heaven and received their rewards.

But when will this happen? Can we know? Yes, we can know. Because we read from the beginning of chapter 5 from verse 1 to 10:

- Revelations 5:1** And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals.
- 2 And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof?
 - 3 And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon.
 - 4 And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look thereon.
 - 5 And one of the elders says unto me, Weep not: **behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, has prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.**
 - 6 And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, **stood a Lamb** as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.
 - 7 And he came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon the throne.
 - 8 And when he had taken the book, the four beasts **and four and twenty elders** fell down before the Lamb, having every one of them harps, and golden vials full of odors, which are the prayers of saints.
 - 9 And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for you were slain, and have redeemed us to God by your blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;
 - 10 And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.



If we focus on this scripture we see the overcomers in heaven with their rewards, **before** Jesus opens the seals of this book. By this we can know the period of time when the true church of the overcomers will be raptured in heaven, seated on their thrones and received all the promised rewards, before Jesus opens the seals. Amen?

Now let's see what happens on the earth after Jesus opens the seals. Later if you have more time you can read the whole book, but for now I want to focus on two seals. What happens only when Jesus opens two of the seals? In chapter 6 verses 3 and 4,

Revelations 6:3 And when he had opened the **second seal**, I heard the second beast say, Come and see.

4 And there went out another horse *that was red*: and *power* was given to him that sat thereon to **take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another**: and there was given unto him a great sword.

So, when Jesus opens this seal, peace is taken from the earth. In all history until today, was the earth ever without any peace?

Always there was peace somewhere on the earth. But when Jesus opens this seal no more peace in the earth. Not only in one place but in all the earth; no peace. And people killing each other, that's what is written in verse 4:

...to take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another...

Let's look at another thing that happens on the earth when Jesus opens another seal. Let's read what it happens when he opens the third seal in verse 7:

Revelation 6:7 And when he had opened the **fourth seal**, I heard the voice of the fourth beast say, Come and see.

Rev 6:8 And I looked, and behold a pale horse: and his name that sat on him was Death, and Hell followed with him. And power was given unto them **over the fourth part of the earth, to kill with sword, and with hunger, and with death, and with the beasts of the earth.**



With every seal Jesus opens, something happens on the earth. In the second seal peace is taken from the earth and people killing one another. But in this fourth seal, when Jesus opens this one seal, one fourth of the earth will be killed, will die. One fourth of the earth will be killed. How many people are on the earth now? About eight billion people. So, if it is one fourth of eight billion, how many people will be killed on earth when Jesus opens this one seal? **Two billion people.**

This never happened in history. In all the world wars all who died never reached this number.

So, when we see Jesus opening the seals in heaven, on earth we can say, great tribulation is happening.

Will the church of the overcomers be in the **Great Tribulation**? No! Say it with confidence. No! Say: I am an overcomer and I will be in heaven with my rewards as my Jesus promised. The great tribulation is not for me.

Because in Thessalonians Paul says we are not appointed unto wrath,

1Thessalonians 5:9 For God has not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ,

Let's see together a very sad thing (for me). In chapter 7 of Revelations verse 9,

Revelations 7:9 After this I beheld, and, lo, a **great multitude**, which **no man could number**, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands;

We see great multitude now in heaven, no one can number from every nation, every people, every tribe and every tongue. Who are these?

Please read verses 13 and 14,

Revelations 7:13 And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? and from where came they?

14 And I said unto him, Sir, you know. And he said to me, These are they **which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.**

So, who are they? They are taken **out of great tribulation** from every nation, every people, every tribe and every tongue. **They washed their robes and made them white by the blood of the Lamb.**

What does that mean? Their robes were dirty (they already had white robes of salvation). Dirty with sin. Dirty with the world. Dirty with the sins of the flesh. These had their robes dirty, and they entered the great tribulation. Because when they saw the others were taken in the rapture, and that they were left behind and passed through the great tribulation, because of God's mercy and goodness, He gave them another chance to repent.

The Bible shows us that they repented later in the great tribulation **and they washed their robes and made them white with the blood of the Lamb.** And that is why they were taken out to heaven with white robes and only palms on their hands, standing on their feet, not seated on thrones, no crowns of gold, only white robes and palms in their hands.

This group went into great tribulation. Who say so? The Bible. In verse 14


14 And I said unto him, Sir, you know. And he said to me, These are they **which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.**

These came from great tribulation.

And verse 15,

Revelations 7:15 Therefore are they before the throne of God, and serve him day and night in his temple: and he that sits on the throne shall dwell among them.

So, what is the difference between this group and the first group? The first group **seated on thrones** and **shall reign with Christ having crowns of gold** and the second group is **standing and serving** day and night.



The difference between these two groups is very clear in the Bible. Is this my interpretation? Or. Is it written? Therefore you can stand on the Word of God and preach and teach the Word of God.

To wake up the people; it is written: **“without holiness no one will see the Lord”**. Amen?

Heb 12:14 Follow peace with all *men*, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:

Therefore we can call people to repentance, not because we are better. No! We stand by grace, we repent first then we can help others to repent. We overcome first, then we can help others to overcome.

He who has ears to hear, let him hear what the Spirit is saying to the churches. If they receive you, they receive Who sent you; if they reject you, they reject the One who sent you. So, don't be discouraged by their reaction. Always strengthen yourself in the Lord and in the power of His might, and always seek to please the Lord. Never try to please men.

When the Lord told me to go to Argentina in 2003, before going he allowed me to read books about Argentina. I didn't know that I was going to be there. And they talked about how the Lord sent many prayer warriors, intercessors to do spiritual warfare. So, from what I read I thought that Argentina had a very beautiful spiritual atmosphere!

But when I went there I was shocked, I did not feel the presence of God. I felt the presence of the enemy and a very heavy oppression. I said; Lord, I don't understand, you sent prayer warriors, generals of prayer warriors and intercession and spiritual warfare. Why I don't feel your presence? Why I feel the presence of the enemy?

And the Lord said; Because there is no **REPENTANCE!**

If there is no repentance that gives legal ground for the enemy to stay. So, the Lord said: Go, wake my people up to righteousness. Tell my people to repent, I'm coming back very soon. I'm not coming back for a carnal church. I'm not coming back for a worldly church. I'm not coming back for a selfish, self seeking church. I'm coming back for a pure, holy church, sanctified without blemish and without spot. And without holiness no one will see the Lord.

So, this is the commission I received from the Lord, and this commission I impart to you in Jesus' name. Do you receive this commission?

Spend time with the Lord! Seek Him, seek the Lord.

In the first session of this teaching, you students stood up to lay down everything for Jesus. You are here to study God's Word, to be equipped, to be prepared to go on and speak His Word. But also to wake up other people to repentance, to be equipped to be men and women of God. That you become light to the world and the light dispels the darkness. To be good salt.

Why does darkness come? If the light is shining can there be darkness?

Darkness comes because the light is not shining! Why the corruption and the decay comes? Because there is no good salt. Good salt stops decay and corruption.

So, ask yourself, Am I shining? Darkness must go! Because darkness cannot overcome the light!.

At night if the room is dark, turn on the light and you will see what happens...

Darkness must go! Not us, we are the light. We don't have to go. Darkness has to go. Amen? So, this is a challenge for you, everyday say: Jesus let me shine for you! More and more!

The more Jesus lives in you, the more light shines out. The more light shines out, the more darkness disappears. Do you like to see this in your city? Do you want to see this in your country?

The Bible says that we don't wrestle against flesh and blood; we wrestle against principalities and powers of darkness. And the one Who is in us, is greater than he who is in the world. We can overcome by the power of His Blood, by the power of the light of the gospel of Jesus Christ, by the power of His love, because love overcomes hatred, light overcomes darkness.

In the next session we will learn more about spiritual warfare, how to put on the armour of God and how to put on the armour of love. Is there an armour of love? I will show you tomorrow by the Word of God.

It is time to see God's glory. Jesus is coming back very soon, but he wants pure and holy vessels to fill with his glory, to clothe with His power, to shine with His glory. And satan is defeated in Jesus' name. We shall see God's glory. The church is not leaving this world in defeat.

Did Jesus leave this earth in defeat? No! Jesus left this world with victory and glory. And the real church of the overcomers is going to leave the earth in victory and glory.

So, let's prepare our hearts, let's prepare our vessels. We are the vessels of the Lord, to be in purity and holiness to receive the presence and the glory of the Lord.

Prayer to close the first day seminar:

Holy Spirit, in obedience Lord, I spoke what you gave me utterance of, and I trust you Father that your Word will not go back to you void, but will succeed and prosper in everyone that heard it today. It will be in good soil that you'll protect by the power of your Holy Spirit. Send the early and later rain, to water your seeds, let them grow and bear abundant fruit. That your Word also produce fruit in others and multiply many folds to cover the whole world, according to your promise Father. The earth shall be full with the knowledge of your glory as the waters cover the seas.
